Bolton IAS also support young people directly, and cover Education, Health and Social care.  Bolton Children's Opportunity Group (COG) is a local Registered Charity, whose aim is to provide a stepping stone between home and playgroup and/or nursery, for under 5s with disabilities and/or special educational needs. COG gives parents the chance to meet others with similar problems, so they can be of mutual support.  Short breaks provide a specialist service which aims to support disabled children and their families, over and above those opportunities available to all families. The service includes providing a break from caring to support a parent or carer to continue to look after their child in the long term; to enable disabled children to participate in safe, fun and interesting activities.
