I am writing to express my concern regarding road safety around our school; following a recent incident were a child was nearly knocked over. Thankfully no harm was caused on this occasion, but it serves as an important reminder of the need for caution when driving and parking near to the school.

To ensure the safety of all our children, we kindly ask for your cooperation in the following matters:-

- 1. \*\* Drive slowly and carefully \*\* in the vicinity of the school, especially during drop-off and pick-up times.
- 2. \*\* Escort your children safely across the road \*\* if needed, rather than letting them cross alone.
- 3. \*\* Do not park on the yellow zig-zag lines \*\* outside the school gates. These are no-parking zones to ensure visibility and safety for everyone.
- 4. \*\* Be mindful when parking \*\* avoid blocking roads/paths or creating unnecessary hazards for pedestrians and other drivers.

Please be assured that I am in touch with both the Highways Department and the local police to address these concerns. We are working together to improve road safety measures and ensure the protection of everyone in our school community.

The safety of our children is our highest priority, and rely on your support to maintain a safe environment around the school.
