Our current class novel is 'The magic finger' by Roald Dahl. In writing, we will be producing our own fable based on 'The Boy Who Cried Wolf'. We will also continue looking at the use of inverted commas and adjectives within grammar and continuing to develop our understanding of subordinate clauses.



In maths, we will continue to develop our basic maths skills. We will work on mental and formal calculation methods for the four operations and we will begin to look at fractions of objects and numbers and telling the time to the nearest 5-minute interval. Children will also be focussing on quick recall of times tables and division facts.

Our Learning

History- Our history topic this term will be The Romans. Within this topic children will be finding out about what life was like in Ancient Rome and look at why the Roman army was successful.

Geography- Our geography topic this term will be Who lives in Antarctica? Within this topic children will be learning about different climates and the journey of Shackleton.

PE- Our PE lessons will be on Tuesday and Friday. We will focus on Gymnastics and handball. We will develop our knowledge of the types of passes, tactics to defend and attack.

RE- Our theme in RE is 'Giving All'. We will look at different people and answer the question of 'What makes some people give everything for other people?'

PHSE- In PHSE, we will be completing our RHE topic from Ten Ten - life to the full. A letter was sent home to inform you of the subjects we will be discussing.

Can I help my child at home?

You can help your child at home by:

• Supporting them with their reading.

Children should read at home every night. They should sign their diary 5 times each week. Please check your child's diary and sign it every week.

• Supporting them with their homework.

Homework will be given out on Monday. Children should complete their homework and return it to school by the following Friday at the latest. If children have any problems with their homework, they should bring it to school and ask for help before the date that it is due.

• <u>Learning times tables and division</u> facts.

In year 3 our focus is on 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's, 8's and 10's. Children must learn multiplication and division facts off by heart. Being able to recall these facts rapidly enables children to solve a range of calculations and problems in their Maths work.
