#### Plants and animals


We will be learning about plants and how they grow. The children will be growing their own vegetables. We will also be welcoming caterpillars into our

The children will be concentrating on hearing all the sounds in each word and writing them down. Then



using these words to create a sentence. They are focusing on writing words which have the ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, ar sounds in. e.g. play, sheep, high, snow, park). Please help your child to recognise these sounds in their reading book and practise writing these sounds in sentences in their home learning book.



## **Mathematics**

In maths we are focusing on the numbers above ten. We will be learning to say them in order and understand what they are made up of. We will be solving problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

We will also be learning to recall some number bonds to 10.

### How can you help your child at home?


- Share stories with your child
