Maths



In maths, we will continue to develop our basic maths skills and we will work on mental and formal calculation methods for the four operations. We will begin to identify the properties of 3D shapes and interpreting data from bar charts.

Our Learning

History- Our history topic this term will be Ancient Egypt. Within this topic children will be finding out about what life was like in Ancient Egypt and what they believed happened to them after death.

Geography- Our geography topic this term will be 'Are all settlements the same?'. Within this topic children will be will look at features of their local area and compare them to New Delhi.

PE- Our PE lessons will be on Tuesday and Friday. We will focus on athletics and dance. We will develop our techniques in sprinting and throwing and will also learn a set routine in dance.

RE- Our theme in RE is 'Listening and Sharing'. We will learn about listening to the word of God and how we can follow this in our lives. We will also learn about how we share during Holy Communion.

PHSCE- In PHSCE our topic is called 'Rights and Respect'. In this topic we will be looking at how we can help each other to keep safe and how we should treat other people.

How can I help my child at home?

You can help your child at home by:

- Practising times tables together.
- Listening to your child read at home and discussing the story together.

- Learning to read and spell common exception words.
- Practicing Spellings and completing homework together.
