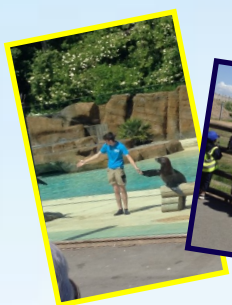
On behalf of all the staff, I wish you and your families a restful and joyful two-week break. May it be a time of peace, togetherness and renewal.
