Thank you to all the parents who came for our Parents Consultation on Wednesday. It was wonderful to see you all.


Dear Lord,

# VIKINGS

History was brought to life as a Viking journeyed to our school this week. The 'invader' (going by the name 'Wayland') set up camp in Year 5 with pupils keen to learn more about the Viking way of life. He showcased a variety of artefacts including iron and wooden cooking pots, the sword and shield he uses as well maps of the Viking world. The 'invader' regaled the pupils with stories about what life was like for Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons, explaining the different way that they engineered their ships which allowed them to move around the world much quicker than anyone had previously thought possible. He told of the many reasons for invading the UK before performing some 'Viking magic' by lighting a fire with flint, which, he said, was believed to contain the spirit of fire. The children were fully immersed in the presentation, asking thoughtful questions as they learnt how most of what we know about Vikings comes from archaeological finds.
