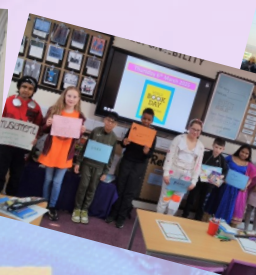
Dear Lord,
