Year 3 and the Ancient Egyptians



On Wednesday our Year 3 class visited the 'Egyptology Collection' at Bolton museum in the town centre as part of their study of this ancient race. The collection of material is arguably one of the most important in a British local authority museum and contains over 12,000 objects. The children were enthralled and totally amazed to see real life Egyptian mummies, and the artefacts that they used in everyday life, including assorted textiles, statues, jewellery, tools, weapons and toys that the children played with. Whilst there they took a tour around a full scale replica of a burial chamber of the pharaoh Tutankhamun that contains fabulous wall scenes that depict the journey into the afterlife!! They learned of the importance of the River Nile in the everyday life of the people, and about the construction of the pyramids and their apparent use. All in all a very worthwhile and informative trip.
