Football League



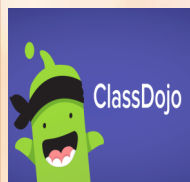
Our football team are taking part in a football league involving a large number of other Bolton schools. Our team played on Thursday and whilst results didn't go our way, they put up a spirited performance.
