The children also participated in a mock trial (of an actual case) about 'Cyberbullying'; were they all played the various roles of the accused, both prosecuting and defending barristers, a jury and a Crown Court judge. The eventual verdict from the jury was 'guilty' which was in line with the actual cases' result.

It was a great experience for the children and gave them a glimpse into the procedures and complexities of the country's judicial system.

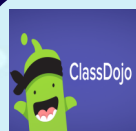
