Using the books we will be writing words, sentences and labelling pictures. Also, we will make our own superhero costumes and use them to help us solve problems in school.

We will be counting objects and recognising and ordering numbers to 20.

We will be learning what is 1 more/less than a number. Also, we will be practising adding by combining 2 groups of objects and counting all of them together. This will follow with us completing simple addition number sentences.

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This term we will be learning about the following statements:

- Jesus was born for everyone.
- Jesus is God's Son and came for everyone.
- We need to show love to everyone like Jesus.

We will be listening to different scripture from the Bible. The two main stories we will focus on are: The Good Samaritan and Jesus Feeds the 5000.
