In English this term, we will be writing for a range of purposes and will be focusing on enhancing the effectiveness of our writing by including a range of descriptive elements, as well as using a range of punctuation and conjunctions. We will also spend some time this term editing and improving our writing.

Maths Times tables focus: **x10**



In Maths this term, we will be focusing on multiplication and division, solving money problems and looking at the length and height of objects. We will also revisit answering questions involving addition and subtraction and we will continue to develop our problem solving and reasoning skills.

Wider Curriculum

History- This term, the children will develop their historical skills and understanding when answering the unit's enquiry question 'How did we learn to fly?' They will develop an understanding of how aviation has changed over time and learn about key figures who are remembered for their work in relation to the history of aviation.

Geography- Children will continue to use a range of maps and atlases to locate countries around the world. They will begin to use a range of geographical vocabulary to describe places and give an opinion as to why they think the world is a wonderful place.

Art- The children will be looking at mixed media art. They will be experimenting with colour and exploring how artists use colour and mixed media to create effective pieces of art.

Science- Our science focuses this term are 'Use of Everyday Materials' and 'Life Cycles and Health'. Within these units, the children will look at a range of life cycles and use scientific vocabulary to describe how to stay healthy. They will also identify a range of everyday materials and explain why these materials are best suited for a particular purpose.

DT - Our DT unit of work this term, is all about mechanisms. The children will have the chance to explore a range of working mechanisms and plan, create and evaluate their own fairground wheel.

Computing- We will continue to practise logging on and off efficiently and deepen our understanding of how to use technology safely. We will also be developing our understanding of how 'Microsoft Word' can be an effective word processing package and begin to use some of its simple features.

RE- Our RE unit this term is 'Galilee to Jerusalem' throughout this unit the children will become familiar with the words and actions of Jesus during his lifetime. Our virtues to live by this term are; Friendship, Love of Neighbour, Self-Control and Reflection.

Music- During music this term, the children will learn a range of singing techniques and will be learning a range of songs to perform during our class assembly.

PE- Our PE lessons will be on a Tuesday and Friday. On a Friday the children will develop a range of dance skills and will be creating their own dance routines. On a Tuesday they will continue to develop their teamwork skills with Rees sports.

RHSE – Children will be thinking about why they are special and how they are different to others.

How can I help my child at home?

You can help your child at home by:

- Practising counting in different steps together (2's, 5's, 10's and 3's) and learning number facts/times tables.
- Listening to your child read at home and discussing the story together. Children should read at home every night and they need to have their diary signed **5 times each week.**
- Learning to read and spell common exception words.
- Practising spellings and completing homework together.
