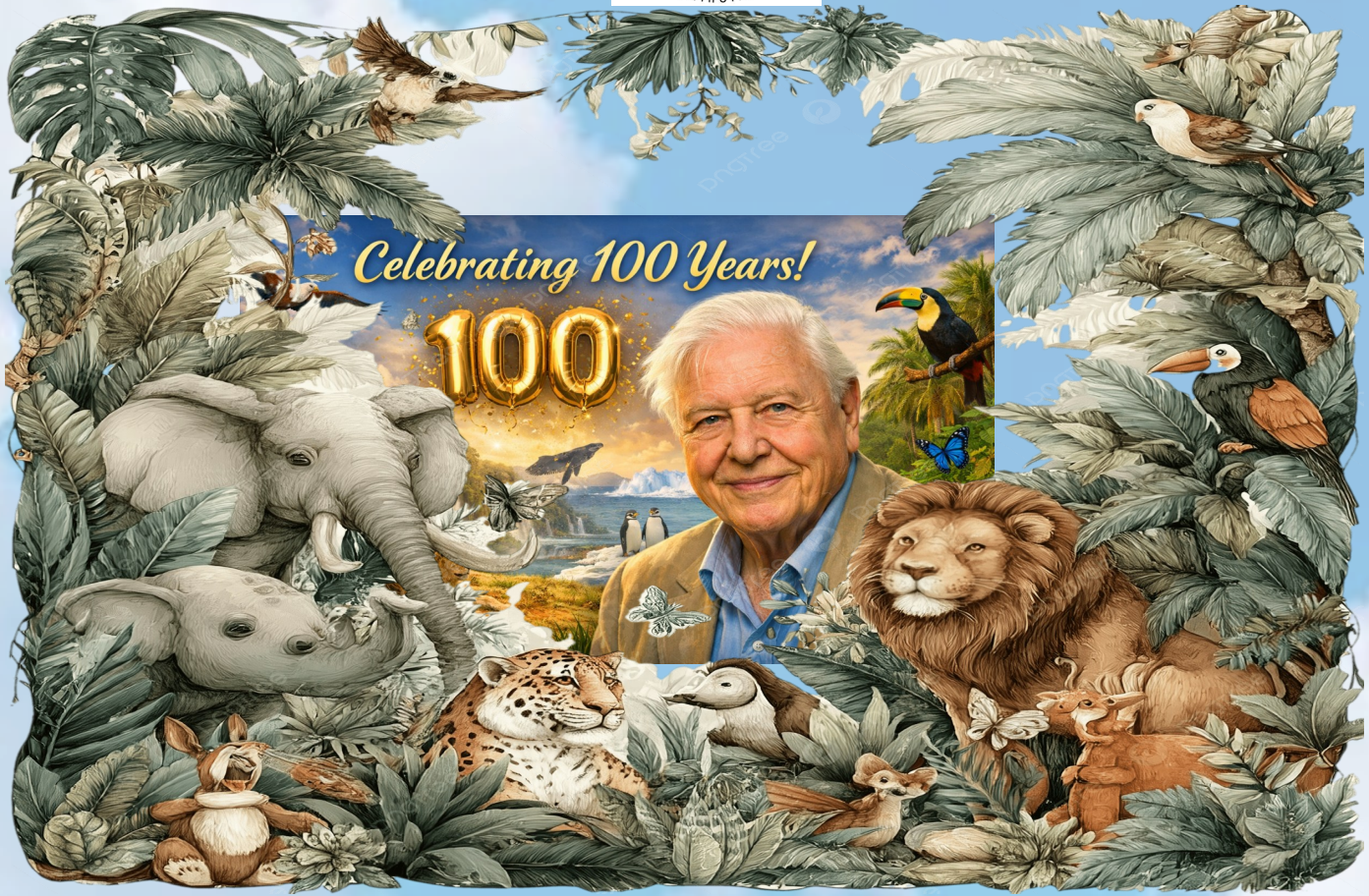


# May 8th 2026

Well done to Year 4 who are this week's attendance superstars with 99.1%

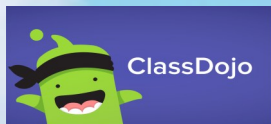
Year 3 are our most punctual class.
